


FREE GENERAL ACCESS & PARKING

ski passes

A Three Rivers Park District Cross-country Ski Pass is required for skiers age 12 and older.

All Parks Pass - Required at Elm Creek and Hyland, where snowmaking offers a reliable season of skiable snow. Valid at all Three Rivers parks offering cross-country skiing.

Natural Snow Parks Pass - Valid at all Three Rivers parks offering cross-country skiing, except Elm Creek and Hyland.

Season passes are available online or at any Three Rivers visitor center, ski chalet, nature center, and the Administrative Center. Daily ski passes are available at trailhead pay boxes, visitor centers, and ski chalets.

- Minnesota Ski Passes are not required in Three Rivers Park District.
- Skijouring and fat bikes are allowed on the Cleary Lake Golf Course Trail and the Eagle Lake Eagle Trail with a ski pass.
- Multi-use/skijoring trails do not require a ski pass at Baker, Crow-Hassan, Elm Creek and Murphy-Hanrehan Park Reserves.

for your safety

- Walking and dogs are not allowed on ski trails.
- Ski during park operating hours and only on approved trails.
- Observe directional signs—ski trails are one-way, except where posted as two-way.

Trails are open daily, weather and snow conditions permitting. Ski trails will be closed in case of severe weather, insufficient snow, icy conditions, air temperature of -25° or lower, or windchill of -35° F or lower.
